FOOD BOX MINISTRY

Several years ago, as an additional outreach of our Starfish Ministry,
our Missions Team began a Food Box Ministry.

The purpose of this ministry was to provide additional help to families
in our community dealing with food insecurity.

Our Missions Team developed a menu for the Food Boxes designed
to feed a family of four for a week. This box consists of non-
perishable food, such as pasta with sauce, canned meats, rice,
canned vegetables, and breakfast items.

In addition, the team developed an "Essentials Bag" with basic kitchen
items such as plastic spatulas, spoons, salt, pepper, and cooking oil.
The Team also developed a "Non-Kitchen Bag" to assist those in our
community that are currently homeless.

This ministry is designed to help those experiencing a difficult situa-
tion where they need a temporary hand-up to get them through a
tough time. We have had overwhelming success with this ministry
and many families and individuals have been given assistance.

You have an opportunity to play an important part in this ministry.
When you are shopping for your own family, take a moment to pick up
a couple of items for our Food Box Ministry. You can simply drop
them off in the cart in the main hallway of the church at your conven-
ience. Any of the items mentioned above will be helpful. In the future,
we will begin focusing on particular items each month which are need-
ed for our ministry.
